

GREEK SWIMMER VAZAIOS TAKES GOLD AT EUROPEAN SHORT COURSE CHAMPIONSHIP

Twenty-seven-year-old Greek swimmer Andreas Vazaios won the gold medal in the 200-meter Individual Medley at the European Short Course Championships in Kazan, Russia on Friday. Vazaios won the same event in Glasgow in 2019 to go along with a gold medal in the 200-meter butterfly. Friday he raced out to an early lead and held off the hard-charging Italian duo of Thomas Ceccon and Alberto Razzetti.



A two-time Olympian in 2012 and 2016, Vazaios also swam at North Carolina State University and was an NCAA champion twice in the 200-yard butterfly. While at NC State, Vazaios was also a two-time champion as a member of the 800-freestyle relay team that set school, ACC, and NCAA records.
